Grand Opening Weekend for Stoup Brewing Beer Garden



The occasion will be marked by the release of Stoup's Citra IPA. In addition to a full range of beers on tap, Fez on Wheels will be parked out front to feed the hungry. Beer lovers and non-drinkers alike can also indulge in Soda Jerk Sodas and ice cream from Balleywood Creamery.

Adding to the fun, Caricature artists Christina and Clifton Landry of 4D-Artistry will provide fun(ny) remembrances of the celebration.







The festivities continue on Sunday May 10, also known as Mother's Day, when we're offering \$1 off pints for moms and Taylor Shell-fish will be shucking and grilling fresh northwest oysters for \$2 a piece from 1pm until they run out.
